The Central Texas Bluegrass Association (CTBA or Association) is dedicated to furthering the enjoyment of bluegrass music through teaching, sharing and playing. Incorporated in 1978 as a Texas non-profit, tax-exempt corporation, the Association welcomes all bluegrass friends, fans, and pickers to become active members.

The CTBA Board of Directors established this Scholarship to assist the recipient in covering the cost of tuition at any bluegrass camp or workshop. The Board also sets the amount of this Scholarship. Tuition, for the purposes of this Scholarship, is defined as follows:

- If the tuition includes room or board, then the Scholarship includes the room or board.
- If the tuition does not include room or board, then the Scholarship does not include room or board.

The Association pays the scholarship amount directly to the organization providing the camp or workshop.

The recipient of the scholarship will be responsible for all travel expenses and other expenses incurred.

Applicants must be between the ages of 12 and 21, inclusive. Applicants must also be residents of Texas.
