Jamie then proposed that we do the meeting at the Mercer Street Dance Hall in Dripping Springs, perhaps on the Saturday night. It was suggested that money could be charged at the door and CTBA members could get a discount.
- Raffle for fall meeting: Eddie Collins has a guitar for the raffle.

New Wimberley Jam - Bob received an email about a proposed jam in Wimberley at a food truck / wine garden at RR12 & FM 32 between San Marcos & Wimberley.

The Leander Jam is expanding from two hours to three hours.
